THE ARAB AWAKENING:

THE CRISIS IN SYRIA:

Al Jazeera covered the crisis in Syria from all angles, reporting on political movements, both major and minor, meeting with representatives from the rebels and the government. Furthermore, our analysis of the ever-deteriorating refugee situation placed a human focus on the millions of people affected by the crisis.

THE CRISIS IN EGYPT:

Unlike most networks, Al Jazeera shows all sides of the story. Despite the challenges faced by Al Jazeera in Egypt, our coverage continues to be the most comprehensive, always echoing the voice of the people.

LEAKED IRAQ WAR DOCUMENTS (2010):

Al Jazeera was the first international broadcaster to air analytical coverage and programmes that revealed startling new information about the operations of U.S. forces during the Iraq War (Wikileaks).

THE WAR ON GAZA (2009):

Al Jazeera provided live and comprehensive coverage of the war from both Gaza and Israel. With its unique access, Al Jazeera became the consistent and credible news source, both for viewers and other media.

THE ISRAELI WAR ON LEBANON (2006):

Al Jazeera provided live coverage of the Lebanon-Israel conflict for 33 days from 5 different locations in Lebanon and northern Israel. Al Jazeera's coverage of the war was picked up by media outlets across the world.

TODAY'S HARVEST

An extensive round up of the day's news coverage, bringing viewers the headlines along with in-depth reports, analysis and interviews from around the world.

BEHIND THE NEWS

A daily current affairs programme looking at a major news story of the day, providing analysis into what is behind the news to shed light on the origins and consequences of the event.

IN DEPTH

A weekly debate show that deals with political issues and events and explores the implications in their wider context. Introducing experts into the public discussion, the show analyses causes, consequences, and methods on which these issues rest.

WITHOUT BOUNDS

A programme that brings viewers closer to today's current affairs developments through an open interview with an expert.

OPPOSITE DIRECTION

The chance to hear both sides of the story. As two guests discuss, the live programme spares no effort in trying to win the usually heated debate in support of his or her case.

THE OBSERVATORY

Al Marsad (The Observatory) is a weekly media-oriented show that closely monitors and features up-to-date Arab and world media issues.

REVOLUTION RHETORIC

A lively talk show that discusses scenes of the modern revolution in the Arab world with comment and analysis from senior political figures.

FROM WASHINGTON

Journalists, thinkers, analysts and decision makers from the US discuss the week's news, politics and power, to understand the implications for the wider global economic scene.

UNDER THE MICROSCOPE

A weekly investigative programme uncovering facts about pressing current affairs.

BLACK BOX

A monthly documentary programme that investigates and analyses conspiracies and major crises in the Arab world.
